Cheesy Ham Bubble Bakes

INGREDIENTS:

pkg. (6 oz.) OSCAR MAYER Smoked Ham 3/4 cup KRAFT Shredded Cheddar Cheese

1 can (12 oz.) refrigerated buttermilk biscuits (10 biscuits)

DIRECTIONS:

HEAT oven to 350°F.

CHOP ham; mix with cheese in large bowl.

CUT each biscuit into 4 pieces. Add to ham mixture; mix lightly. Spoon into 8 muffin cups sprayed with cooking spray.

BAKE 20 min. or until puffed and golden brown. Cool 10 min. before removing from pan. Serve warm.

Special Extra: Serve with your favorite sweet or savory condiment such as honey, maple-flavored or pancake syrup, KRAFT Ranch Dressing, KRAFT Real Mayo Mayonnaise or mustard.

Variation: Substitute OSCAR MAYER Smoked Turkey Breast for the ham and KRAFT Shredded Mozzarella Cheese for the Cheddar cheese. Also, instead of baking in muffin cups, spoon ham mixture into 8 mounds on baking sheet sprayed with cooking spray, then bake as directed.


